A DYNAMIC NEW VERTICAL COMMUNITY IN EAST LONDON

This May marks the launch of Manhattan Loft Gardens – an ambitious East London venture by Harry Handelsman, founder of Chiltern Firehouse and the restored St Pancras Renaissance Hotel. Designed by SOM, the spectacular double-cantilevered, 42-storey tower features 248 single and double-height loft apartments, three sky gardens, two restaurants and a design hotel.

The Stratford Hotel will occupy the first six storeys of the building, with 145 guest rooms and suites. The hotel's interiors have been created by Danish design studio, Space Copenhagen, and celebrate the timeless glamour and communal spirit of 1950s New York's long-stay hotels.

Natural timbers, warm metals and stone-clad bathrooms fuse cutting-edge style with old-world opulence.
