Stratford has been upping its foodie game in recent years with the likes of [Darkhorse](#) and [Signorelli](#) in the East Village, but its newest opening cranks things up even further. Looming large over Westfield is a new 42-storey hotel and apartment building – and its triple-height, monochrome lobby is home to glossy new restaurant [The Stratford Brasserie](#).

Make no mistake: this is special dinner territory. The menu, by ex-Soho House chef Ben Harrington, is extensive so stick to the pimped-up seasonal dishes: a shock of green tomato gazpacho with silky stracciatella was the ultimate refresher on a sweltering summer day, while panna cotta with strawberries was lifted by tiny balsamic pearls. Want to extend your evening? Head upstairs to the mezzanine bar for a DJs-and-seriously-boozy-cocktails late-night vibe. Stratford, we applaud you.
